In November the department was notified of 21 confined space entries for local businesses and the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

The Inspections Division inspected, plan reviewed or consulted 9 businesses in November.

Department members trained 275 hours on pump operations, apparatus check procedures, general driver training, driving laws and ordinances, water supply, foam operations, pre-incident planning, monthly drill, NFPA 1410 evolution, specialty rescue equipment, confined space, and trench rescue.

In November, department members gave station tours to area pre-school and elementary school children. In addition, one car seat installation check was provided. These services were given to 55 adults and 130 children.

The department continues to participate in the city smoke detector program; the department provides free smoke detectors for residents in the community and staff members to install smoke detectors in those homes.
