

Warsaw Traffic Safety Commission

A scheduled meeting of the Warsaw Traffic Safety Commission was held Wednesday, April 17, 2013, at 1:00 p.m. at the Warsaw Police Department. **Voting members in attendance were: Joel T. Beam, Mike Klondaris, Steve Foster, and Greg Schroeder and Kip Shuter.** Absent voting members: **Dan Robinson and Cindy Dobbins.** Ex-Officio members in attendance: Mayor Thallemer, Lacy Francis, Jeremy Skinner and Scott Whitaker. Also in attendance was Times-Union reporter, Jennifer Peryam, and Stacey Page, The Paper.

Kip Shuter called the meeting to order.

Minutes of the March 6, 2013 Traffic Commission meeting were approved. Mike Klondaris made motion seconded by Greg Schroeder.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. Downtown Parking - For the purpose of discussion for the minutes, Kip Shuter reported that the on street committee had completed their work and that that summarization will be submitted to the Traffic Safety Commission, along with the off street committee report. Mayor Thallemer requested that the input from the finance committee be submitted at the same time. A May 1, 2013 target date has been set for the Traffic Commission in order to submit recommendation to the Warsaw City Council by early summer.

2. Market Street No Parking – Kip Shuter made motion seconded by Mike Klondaris not to make any changes regarding parking on East Market Street between Wood Street and Argonne Road. Waiting for final engineering and long term solutions.

3. Railroad Crossings – Mayor Thallemer reported that he has had communication with Norfolk & Southern and INDOT regarding Winona Ave, Market Street, Main Street crossings regarding crossing arms awaiting favorable conclusion. Mike Klondaris advised that Pope Street should also be considered.

NEW BUSINESS:

1.Contract to Regulate Traffic WCS – Contract copy was presented for review by Kip Shuter and Greg Schroeder. This is a continuation of current contract with some minor upgrades. Awaiting approval of WCS legal counsel before submission to the Warsaw Board of Public Works and the Warsaw Community School Board.

2. Provident Court- Mike Klondaris requested attention be given to the area regarding posted speed limit and lane markings. Kip Shuter will look into same.

The next regular scheduled meeting is May1, 2013 at 1:00 p.m. Location to be announced.

Kip Shuter adjourned the meeting.
