A scheduled meeting of the Warsaw Traffic Safety Commission was held Wednesday, August 7, 2013, at 1:00 p.m. at the Warsaw City Council Chambers. **Voting members in attendance were: Joel T. Kip Shuter called the meeting to order.

Minutes of the June 5, 2013 Traffic Commission meeting were approved. Cindy Dobbins made motion seconded by Mike Klondaris.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- 1. Downtown Parking Update** - Kip Shuter gave members update regarding ordinances passed by city council. Implementation and coordination with legal advertisement relating to the changes and signage changed or removed. Date of implementation is September 1, 2013. Kip Shuter and Lacy Francis will review and make signage changes necessary before September 1, 2013.
- 2. Railroad Crossings** – Mayor Thallemer reported that he has had communication with Norfolk & Southern regarding Pope Street, Winona Ave, Market Street, Main Street, and Fort Wayne Street, crossings regarding crossing arms, awaiting favorable conclusion,

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Park Ridge “no parking”** – Nick Schrauder made the request regarding “blind spot” near children play area. Matter tabled for additional information (photo) and investigation.
- 2. Prairie & Buffalo** – Margaret Reisert requested the removal of “no-left turn” restriction for traffic on Buffalo Street (SR 15) at Prairie Street. Mike Klondaris made motion denying the request, Joel Beam seconded.
- 3. Market & Detroit Pedestrian Traffic** – Request for “No Right on Red” for westbound traffic was made to Mayor Thallemer and Councilman Mike Klondaris. The intersection is the responsibility of INDOT. Want to coordinate with existing plans & infrastructure. Mike Klondaris made motion for Kip Shuter to contact INDOT for input seconded by Greg Schroeder.
- 4. Market & Buffalo** – Request for 15 parking/loading zone for Brent Cox, Indiana Antiques was approved for the last space on Market Street on the NE corner of Market and Buffalo. Traffic Commission will wait for further information for ordinance change.

The next regular scheduled meeting is September 4, 2013 at 1:00 p.m. Location to be announced.

Kip Shuter adjourned the meeting.
