

Warsaw Traffic Safety Commission

A regularly scheduled meeting of the Warsaw Traffic Safety Commission was held Wednesday, January 8, 2014, at 1:00 p.m. at the Warsaw Police Department. **Voting members in attendance were: Joel Beam, Cindy Dobbins, Mike Klondaris, Greg Schroeder, and Kip Shuter.** Absent voting members: **Steve Foster, and Dan Robinson.** Ex-Officio members in attendance: Mayor Thallemer, Lacy Francis, Jeremy Skinner, and Scott Whitaker. Kip Shuter called the meeting to order.

Minutes of the November 6, 2013 Traffic Commission meeting were approved. Greg Schroeder made motion, seconded by Mike Klondaris.

Mayor Thallemer gave the 2014 oath of office to present voting members. Oaths for absent voting members will be given at future meetings.

Cindy Dobbins motioned for Steve Foster to continue as secretary. Second by Joel Beam.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. **Jefferson Street at McKinley Street Stop Signs** – The commission continued discussion on making this intersection a 4-way stop. There was no new data to present. Mike Klondaris motioned to table discussions to allow for MACOG traffic count data, BAC advisory board to make recommendations, allow for pedestrian signage on the path, and utilize a traffic engineering company to make recommendations, before continuing discussions. Second by Greg Schroeder.
2. **Downtown Parking** – Cindy Dobbins inquired on the status of downtown resident parking. Eight (8) spaces have been accounted for in the S. Buffalo City lot. Another eight (8) spaces are planned for a north lot. Jeremy Skinner reported that way finding signage is paid for and in production. He also reported that he is waiting on cost estimates for parking signage.

1. **2013 Annual Traffic Report** – Kip Shuter provided the commission with a summary report from the police department on 2013 traffic activity. See attached.
