

**COMMON COUNCIL  
REGULAR SESSION  
APRIL 21, 2014

The Common Council of the City of Warsaw met in Regular Session on Monday, April 21, 2014 at 7:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Mayor Joseph M. Thallemer presided and the following persons were noted as present or absent:

**OLD BUSINESS-**

Ordinance #2014-03-01 was presented with revisions. The Ordinance establishes rates and charges for the Stormwater Utility. Several changes were noted under section 78-602 in subsections A and F. Stormwater Coordinator Theresa Sailor reviewed the changes and answered questions the Council had. Dr. Nate Bosch from Grace College spoke on the importance of clean water ways in our community and how educating the community will help make our local streams and lakes cleaner. Carey and Mike Lewis from Lewis Salvage offered several comments on the revisions but noted in the end they did not support the Ordinance. After discussion a motion was made by Councilor Call to approve Ordinance #2014-03-1, with the new revisions, seconded by Councilor Quance and carried by unanimous vote. Second reading of the Ordinance will take place during the next scheduled Council Session.
