

## Warsaw Traffic Safety Commission

A scheduled meeting of the Warsaw Traffic Safety Commission was held Wednesday, March 5, 2014, at 1:00 p.m. at the Warsaw Police Department Training Center. **Voting members in attendance were: Joel T. Kip Shuter called the meeting to order.

Minutes of the January 8, 2013 Traffic Commission meeting were approved. Joel T. Beam made motion seconded by Cindy Dobbins.

### UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. **Traffic Control Attention for Jefferson/McKinley** – Mike Klondaris made motion seconded by Cindy Dobbins for the installation of “LED” solar powered lights to enhance visibility of existing Stop Signs at the intersection of McKinley and Jefferson Street.
2. **Downtown Parking Signage Update** – Jeremy Skinner gave members update regarding signage changes. Some rough drafts have been proofed/changed. City will be responsible for installation. Moving forward.

### NEW BUSINESS:

1. **INDOT Flashing Yellow Arrows** – Kip Shuter presented new INDOT information regarding the use of Flashing Yellow Arrows at state controlled intersections throughout the City of Warsaw. The new arrows are currently to be used in new installs and upgrades. US 30 @ 150 West, 200 North, Meijer Drive, Springhill Drive, Commerce Drive, and 250 East are being considered for improvements. The signal control equipment at the intersections of Center Street/Argonne Road/Parker Street, Center Street/Eastlake/Frontage Road, and Argonne/Jefferson Street are the only city intersections that would support this improvement.
2. **INDOT 2015 Safety Project** – US 30 Corridor is scheduled for signalization upgrades to include black signal heads and black background plates for better visibility.

The next regular scheduled meeting is April 2, 2014 at 1:00 p.m.

Kip Shuter adjourned the meeting, having been motioned by Mike Klondaris.
