

## Warsaw Traffic Safety Commission

Wednesday, August 6, 2014

1:00 p.m.

A regularly scheduled meeting of the Warsaw Traffic Safety Commission was held Wednesday, August 6, 2014, at 1:00 p.m. at Warsaw PD. **Voting members in attendance were: Joel Beam, Cindy Dobbins, Mike Klondaris, Dan Robinson, and Kip Shuter.** Absent voting members: **Steve Foster, and Greg Schroeder.** Ex-Officio members in attendance: Mayor Thallemer, and Jeremy Skinner. Also in attendance was Assistant City Planner, Tim Dombrosky. Reporters Stacey Page and Jennifer Peryam were present.

Kip Shuter called the meeting to order.

Minutes of the July 2, 2014 Traffic Commission meeting were approved. Cindy Dobbins made motion, seconded by Mike Klondaris.

### UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. **Updates** – Kip Shuter reported that no progress had been made on the truck route or the traffic agreement with Canterbury.
2. **Update: Bike Route Speed Limits** – Kip Shuter reported that the commission will take the Ride + Walk committee recommendation under advisement and work on these speed limits on a comprehensive basis in the future.
3. **4-Way Stop Request Main at Indiana** – Kip Shuter provided the MUTCD guidelines, MACOG traffic counts, and crash data for the intersection. The vehicular volume only exceeded 300 vehicles in an eight hour period once (12:00 to 1:00 hour). Also only one applicable crash was recorded in the last year when five or more are required. The commission discussed removing the SE corner parking space. Motion was made by Mike Klondaris to do nothing at this time and give it a year to re-examine. Second by Dan Robinson.

### NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Parent Drive Speed Limit** – Kip Shuter reported that he had a citizen request from a resident on Parent Drive to post the speed limit. City planning verified that Parent Drive has been deeded over to the city. After discussion, Dan Robinson motioned to recommend an ordinance to place the Parent Drive speed limit at 25 miles per hour. Second by Cindy Dobbins.
2. **Parking 100 Block of S. High Street** – Mike Klondaris reported that a vehicle has been parking on the west side of the street in an area that does not show yellow curbing and it is unknown if parking should be allowed. Kip Shuter will look at the location and into ordinance to see if there is an ordinance restricting parking there.
3. **Do Not Block Intersection High at Market** – Mike Klondaris reported that he observes traffic block the intersection of High and Market and not allow cross traffic to cross, especially when the traffic is backed up due to a train. No action taken.

Mike Klondaris motioned to adjourn the meeting. The next regular meeting is scheduled for September 3, 2014 at 1:00 p.m.
