UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

1. **State Route 15 Trucks Thru Downtown (Market St)** – Kip Shuter and Jeff Beeler will look at additional signage as well as requesting INDOT provide additional signage along State Road 15 through downtown.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. **200 Blk South Lake Street** – Visibility issue was brought to WTSC concerning vehicles exiting onto S. Lake Street. Steve Foster made motion seconded by Joel T, Beam to eliminate diagonal parking stall just north of egress drive from Mutual Bank onto Lake Street and to extend the painted length of the remaining stalls to 18 feet, an additional 8 feet. When weather permits.
2. **2014 Traffic Report** – Kip Shuter presented copies to commission members. (attached)
3. **City Hall 15 Minute Space** - Mayor Thallemer requested that the possibility of establishing a 15-minute parking stall on Buffalo Street in front of City Hall.
