3. **INDOT & US 30** – Parker Street appears to show no noticeable improvement.
4. **Jake Breaking** – Motor vehicle safety issue per INDOT, no longer a consideration of Traffic Commission.
5. **Park Ridge** – Covenant does not address issue. Some issues can be controlled with existing statutes and ordinances. Additional being collected for next meeting. MACOG traffic counts Table for additional data. Kip Shuter motion, Mike Klondaris second.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. **Lakeview Middle School** - There is a growing concern for student safety crossing Smith Street. Additional lighting has been provided. Portable signalization is a possibility. Additional information to follow.
