ORAL OR WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS

Minutes of the March 4, 2020, meeting was approved. Cindy Dobbins made the motion with Connie Fribley giving a second. The minutes were approved unanimously.

Appointment and Oath for Warsaw Traffic Safety Commission

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Handicap Parking – 500 block of Market Street and Fribley Field –

A motion was made by Cindy Dobbins; seconded by Jack Wilhite to place a handicap parking space on Market Street. Jeff Beeler voted no stressing concern about the parking spaces being proper. Jack Wilhite then changed his vote from yes to no. The remaining members voted yes, and the motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Lakeview Middle School Traffic – Concern was brought to the commission about signage at Lakeview Middle School by Dr. David Ryser. He stressed the importance of adding signage to the opposite side of the road. David Robertson said that he would look at the area. Joel Beam made the motion to add signage and Jack Wilhite seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously. Jeff Beeler will add signage.

Traffic Control at Fisher Avenue and Kincaide St. – Jack Wilhite advised that he had a resident complain reference the intersection at Fisher Ave. and Kincaide Street. It was discussed that traffic counts might help in the area. Joel Beam mentioned that INDOT has looked at that intersection before and that if counts were done it should be when school is in session. Joel Beam went on to say that 8 crashes took place in that intersection area in the last 5 years. All crashes were property damage and no injuries

were reported. Jack Wilhite made a motion to contact MACOG as well as INDOT and see what they can do to help.
