

## Warsaw Traffic Safety Commission

A meeting of the Warsaw Traffic Safety Commission was held Wednesday, June 1, 2011 at 10:30 a.m. at the Warsaw Police Department. Jeremy Skinner moved to approve the March 2, 2011 meeting minutes. Minutes were seconded by Jerry Patterson. Minutes accepted as written.

### OLD BUSINESS:

### NEW BUSINESS:

- 1. Construction Project Updates** – Jeremy Skinner, Lacy Francis and Kip Shuter reported that the Indiana American Water project on SR 15 is scheduled for completion in August. Additionally Indiana American Water will be involved in a project along Maple Street between Ft. Wayne and Clark Street. This project is also scheduled for completion this year.  
Center Street milling and repaving will begin June 6<sup>th</sup>. Project extends from Eastlake intersection to Hickory Street (N/S railroad tracks). Some side streets will receive repairs as well along this route. A signalization project is scheduled for Eastlake/Center intersection. Similar improvements are scheduled for the intersection SR 15 and Rozella Road by INDOT.
- 2. Stop Sign S. West Point Drive/W. Baker Street (Eisenhower Park)**  
Patt Hygema made the request regarding speeding vehicles. It was noted that increased enforcement will take place. Kip Shuter made motion to deny request, seconded by Steve Foster, motion passed. Kip Shuter made and then withdrew a motion for reduction of speed in the area.
- 3. Speed limit reduction La Vista Drive** – Ron Prater made the request. We were informed that this issue is currently being dealt with through enforcement efforts. Kip Shuter made motion to deny the request, seconded by Jerry Patterson. Motion passed.

Jerry Patterson moved to adjourn, seconded by Steve Foster. Meeting adjourned.
